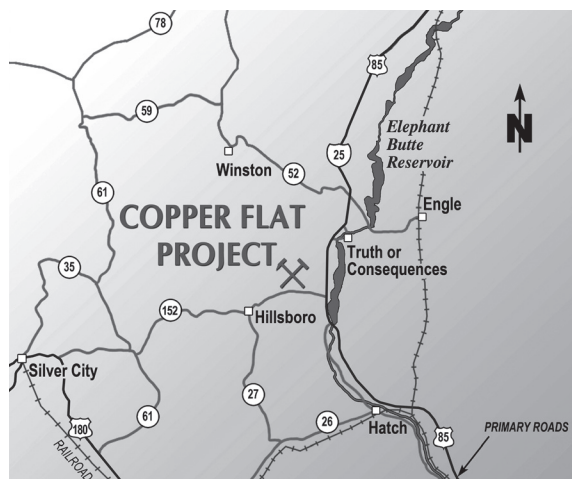


The Copper Flat Mine

What is Copper Flat?



The Copper Flat Mine is a porphyry (PORE-fer-ee) copper/molybdenum deposit located in the Las Animas Mining District in Sierra County, approximately 20 miles southwest of Truth or Consequences.



Planned production for Copper Flat is 36 million pounds of copper per year, which would supply the needs of approximately 800,000 small cars. Copper is primarily used for power generation and transmission, electrical circuitry, construction and transportation. Production is anticipated in 2015.



Copper Flat anticipates employing between 400 and 500 jobs during the two-year construction phase and more than 150 jobs during production.

Copper Flat is committed to recruiting and hiring locally. We are working with the community to create successful job training programs that will benefit the mine and Sierra County residents.
