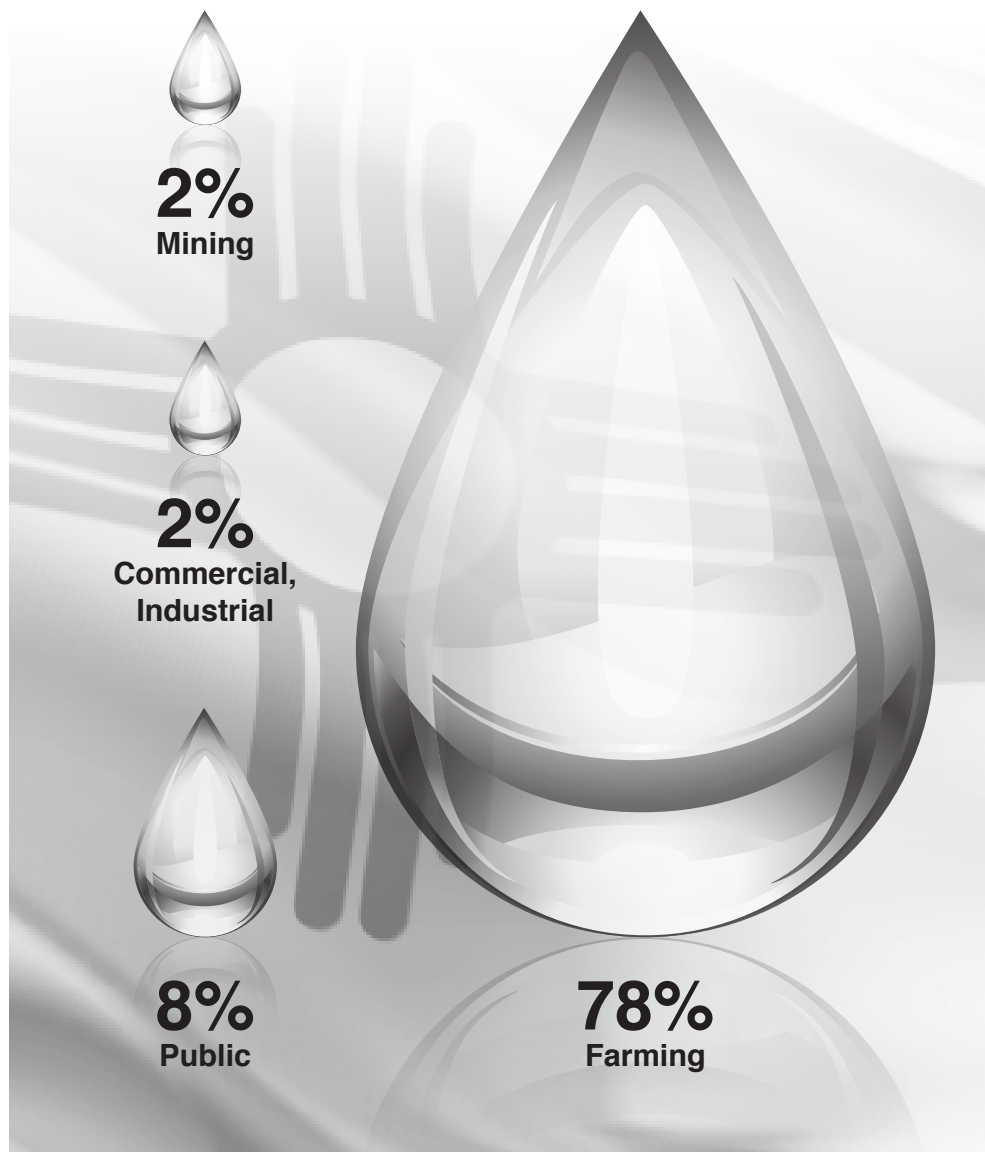


# The Copper Flat Mine Water Use and Revenue Creation



**All industries are important to a vibrant and diversified New Mexico economy.**

Mining in New Mexico uses **2%** of state water and contributes **1.2%** to New Mexico's Gross Domestic Product (GDP), while farming uses **78%** of state water and contributes **1.6%** to GDP.\*

The Copper Flat Mine will use as much water as five to seven average Southwestern golf courses, however will create as much revenue as 52 golf courses.

**7%** of New Mexico's water is lost to evaporation each year.\*

The Copper Flat Mine will use modern technology to recycle water throughout the mining life cycle.
